As well, as part of our exhibition at The Reach, we have taken on an 'outreach' project... conducting art classes with the "Adult and Teen Challenge" community – some of their art may be part of our exhibition at The Reach in November. **Thanks to Yvonne** for bringing this to our attention and **to Deb** for working with the participants.

To close, it has occurred to me as I've visited various art galleries that a lot of contemporary art exhibitions are as much about **ideas and theories** of art as they are about the art itself. It is art that seems to be about the **head**. **In contrast** I would like to suggest that our exhibitions seem to be more about art that is about the heart—about our interest and desire to do art. We like painting. And we dare to put our **heart** and our art on display.

Isn't is interesting that the word 'art' fits so nicely inside the word 'heart'!
